

**The teacher's observation of this scene:**

Children are right at 1 1/2 years. They have been introduced to the trays individually in a separate room away from other children. With one on one modeling on how to work the tray they knew what was expected including returning the tray just as they picked it up. So when I put them all together I was so amazed and pleased to see how well they understood and carried on. The only thing they needed to learn was to take turns at the shelf. They would get so excited a traffic jam would happen at the shelf with trays coming back and leaving so now we are practicing one person at a time. It is rather cute watching them wait like big kids. They are so little!

Other manners we are working on include: setting the tray down quietly, working on the job quietly, and keeping their hands out of others work/trays
